Chairman Gooch received 3 calls regarding the Census. Per Michael Felts, they did receive several calls regarding census takers. They do have some people out locating addresses. They are trying to make sure they have valid addresses...reconciliation with what Granville County has on file. There are individuals verifying the discrepancies. They should not be knocking on doors or interacting with residences. They will walk the neighborhoods to verify addresses. The Census taking...trying to encourage everyone to take the census on line by entering in pre-information. March/April will be the timeframe for the actual census to take place. No one will contact you for this, it's voluntary. Mailers will go out...looking for a complete count. Another mailer will go out in April if they don't have all the information needed. After that, census responders will go out and knock on doors. They will have name badges to identify themselves. Look for updates in the local newspapers with actual dates.
