

AARP DRIVER SAFETY CLASS

FLU SHOT CLINICS TO BE HELD

Granville County Senior Services will once again offer free flu shot clinics for seniors at our senior centers in October. The Granville County Health Department will be sponsoring these clinics. The schedule will be as follows:

> *Granville County Senior Center in Oxford: Wednesday, October 13 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m.

*North Granville Senior Center in Stovall: Tuesday, October 12 8:30 a.m. until 10:30 a.m.

*South Granville Senior Center in Creedmoor: Friday, October 15 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m.

The Health Department will accept Medicare, Medicaid, BCBS, United Healthcare, Humana, Blue Medicare and Coventry. Masks are required and temperatures will be taken.

More than ever, it is important for people of all ages to be protected. The CDC and the NC Division of Public Health recommend everyone over six months of age get a yearly flu vaccine. Children younger than six months are too young to be vaccinated, so those who care for them should be vaccinated instead. Although the best way to avoid getting Influenza is to receive the flu vaccine, frequent hand washing and covering the mouth when coughing are also ways to reduce the spread of flu. Everyone needs to take the necessary steps to stay healthy during flu season—get the shot!

POWERFUL TOOLS FOR CAREGIVERS

The Granville County Senior Center in Oxford will host the *Powerful Tools for Caregivers* series beginning in November. This six-week series gives caregivers the skills they need to take care of themselves while caring for someone else. By taking care of your own health and well-being, you become a better caregiver. Participants will learn how to manage emotions, reduce stress and cope with caregiving issues and demands. Sessions will begin Tuesday, November 2 and will be held each Tuesday through December 7. This free series will be offered both in-person and virtually. In-person sessions will be held from 10:00 a.m. -11:30 a.m. and the virtual option will be held from 1:00 p.m. until 2:30 p.m. on these days. Sessions will be led by Austin Caton, Family Caregiver Specialist and Susan Tucker, Aging Assistant with the Kerr-Tar Area Agency on Aging.

Granville County Animal Control will be at the North Granville Senior Center in Stovall this month to administer *free rabies vaccines* for cats and dogs. NC rabies law requires all owned dogs and cats to be vaccinated against rabies by four months of age, and then to remain current. These will be **one year** vaccines.

Get Ready for Open Enrollment: October 15th Through December 7th

Your health needs change from year to year and the benefits and costs of your health plan may change each year too. That is why it is important to evaluate your Medicare choices every year. The Annual Election Period is the one time of year when all people with Medicare can review and/or change their Medicare Advantage (Part C) or Medicare prescription drug (Part D) plans for 2022. Open enrollment begins *October* 15 and ends *December* 7.

If you would like assistance from one of our award winning SHIIP counselors during this open enrollment time, please call the **Granville County Senior Center** in Oxford at (919)693-1930 to make an appointment. Your appointment can be in person or we can schedule a telephone appointment. IF you choose to come in person, you will be asked to wear a mask.

WHEN YOU COME OR CALL IN FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT, please have your Medicare card and *all of the prescription drugs* that you take on a regular basis with you. We don't need to know about your vitamins or other over-the-counter drugs.

Reminder about extra help paying for prescriptions: Extra help is available for Medicare beneficiaries with limited income and resources. If you qualify, you can take advantage of a program where your premiums are lower (or free), you have lower co-pays, and lower annual deductibles. Currently, the qualifications to receive extra help with your drug plan are:

*For an **individual**: A monthly income below \$1,610 and *resources no greater than \$14,790.

*For a **married couple** living together: A monthly income limit of \$2,178 and *resources no greater than \$29,500.

*Examples of resources that are NOT counted include: your primary residence, your personal possessions, your vehicle(s), life insurance policies, burial expenses and property essential to your self-support. 
VOLUNTEERS RECOGNIZED

SENIOR TARHEEL LEGISLATURE UPDATE

The North Carolina Senior Tar Heel Legislature was created by the North Carolina General Assembly in July 1993. The purpose of the Senior Tar Heel Legislature is to provide information to senior citizens on the legislative process and matters being considered by the NC General Assembly; promote citizen involvement and advocacy concerning aging issues before the NC General Assembly; assess the legislative needs of older citizens by convening a forum modeled after the NC General Assembly and advise and inform the NC General Assembly regarding issues impacting the lives of persons aged 60 and over in North Carolina.

Delegates come from all 100 counties in North Carolina. Granville County's delegate *Annette Myers* will be at the **Granville County Senior Center** in Oxford on Thursday, October 14 at 11:00 a.m. to update us on what the Senior Tar Heel Legislature is working on and what is before the General Assembly that could impact older adults. If you can't join us in-person that day, this presentation will also be live streamed on Facebook live from our Granville County Senior Services Facebook page. MONTHLY SUMMARY OF SERVICES

Granville County Senior Services is hard at work for the citizens of Granville County. The following data reflects the numbers served during **August 2021**.

Home Delivered Meals

Oxford area: 675 meals delivered to 35 homebound seniors.

Northern Granville area: 108 meals served to 5 homebound seniors. Southern Granville area: 500 meals served to 26 homebound seniors.

Total meals: 1,283 meals delivered to 66 homebound seniors. Total contributed to program by participants: \$1,130.95

Total amount paid by Senior Services: \$6,196.89

Congregate Meals

Granville County Senior Center in Oxford: 1,056 served to 76 seniors.

North Granville Senior Center in Stovall: 628 meals served to 47 seniors.

South Granville Senior Center in Creedmoor: 1,448 meals served to 119 seniors.

Total meals: 3,132 meals to 242 seniors.

Total contributed to program by participants: \$1,810.53

Total paid by Senior Services: \$15,127.56
