

GRANVILLE ATHLETIC PARK SPRAY PARK RENTAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Submission of payment for this reservation will serve as acknowledgement and agreement that you have read and will abide by the facility rental rules and regulations as stated below. The act of submission will constitute the electronic rental agreement. A copy of these rules will be emailed to the address associated with the rental upon completion of the reservation process and payment of all fees. Failure to receive the email communication shall not in any way void agreement to abide by these rules and regulations.

- 1. Renter must be at least 21 years of age to secure a reservation.
- 2. The name on the CivicRec account from which the rental reservation is submitted shall be considered the "Responsible Party" for the event and shall be responsible for maintaining order and decorum when using the facility, and to fully inform group members, affiliates, and guests of these rules and regulations.
- 3. The Responsible Party shall be liable for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by any person(s) during the course of the reservation period. All repair or replacement costs incurred as a result of damage, including but not limited to County staff labor costs, will be itemized and billed directly to the Responsible Party.

 All charges must be paid within 30 days to avoid legal action.
- 4. No firearms, fireworks, glass containers, or alcoholic beverages permitted.
- 5. Granville County assumes no responsibility for stolen items or for damage to vehicles in the parking lot.
- 6. Music that is amplified and disturbs others is not permitted.
- 7. The Responsible Party must notify Granville County Parks & Grounds within 24 hours of any weather-related cancellation to have a credit issued for a future rental. Credits do not happen automatically.
