



Outdoor Fireworks Display Permit Process

- 1) Operator(s) must be certified by NC Office of State Fire Marshal. (See sample permit below. Red background indicates Primary Operator. Yellow background will indicate Assistant)
- 2) Any Assistants must be certified by the NC Office of State Fire Marshal.
- 3) Permit must be obtained from Granville County Fire Marshal
 - A. Make application in person
 - B. Present current NCOSFM Pyrotechnics Operator's Permit.
 - C. Present a current Certificate of General Liability Insurance issued from a North Carolina licensed insurance agency. Certificate should have Granville County Fire Marshal as the certificate holder in an amount not less than \$500,000. (Additional coverage may be required depending on the size and location of the show.)
 - D. Pay Granville County permit fee of \$200 at the time of application.
 - E. Upon payment and proper liability certificate, the Granville County Fire Marshal's Office will schedule an on-site inspection to verify compliance with NC Fire Codes. Other conditions may apply at the time of the inspection and/or show.
 - F. Permit will be issued upon successful demonstration of compliance with NC Fire Code and general safety practices and requirements.
 - G. If unfavorable atmospheric conditions exist on the day and time of the show, any and all permits may be revoked at the discretion of the Granville County Fire Marshal's Office.
- 4) Arrangements must be made for dedicated on-site stand-by of fire services and Emergency Medical Services during the actual show.
